1757 - Capt bill takes position

1759 - Music starts – Enya -

1800 - Aaron and his entourage enter to right along with brides maid and flower girls  
– Music Ends and Precession music begins

1802 - Audience stands Tina and her entourage enter to left - music

1805 - Music Stops - Capt. Bill: You may be seated

I want nothing more than to share my future with you – our triumphs, our challenges, our joys and our sorrows. Together, we can accomplish the life we both dream of living.**

**1821 Capt Bill:**

**Tina and Aaron have chosen rings as outward symbols of the commitment they make today, from the earliest times, the ring has been a symbol of wedded love. An unbroken and never-ending circle symbolizing a commitment to love that is never ending." Who presents these Rings – Get Rings and hold them**

***Aaron*, take the ring which you have selected, place it on *Tina*'s finger, and say to her these words." "This ring, a gift for you," (pause) "symbolizes my desire" (pause) "that you be my wife from this day forward."**

***Tina*, take the ring which you have selected, place it on *Aaron*'s finger, and say to her these words. "This ring, a gift for you," (pause) "symbolizes my desire" (pause) "that you be my husband from this day forward."**

**Let these rings serve not as locks binding you together, but as keys, unlocking the secrets of your hearts for each other to know, and thus bringing you closer together forever."**

**1823 – Capt Bill - Sand Ceremony: - Sand Music**

***Tina and Aaron*, today you are making a life-long commitment to share the rest of your lives with each other. Your relationship is symbolized through the pouring of these individual containers of sand; one, representing *Tina* and one representing *Aaron***

**You may now blend the sand together symbolizing the uniting of this family.**

As these grains of sand are poured together they can never be separated. The individual containers of sand will no longer exist, but be joined together as one and forever uniting you as a family.

1827 Capt Bill:

Tina and Aaron, Having witnessed your vows for marriage with all who are assembled here today, and by the power vested in me by the state of Florida, I now pronounce you Husband and wife."
